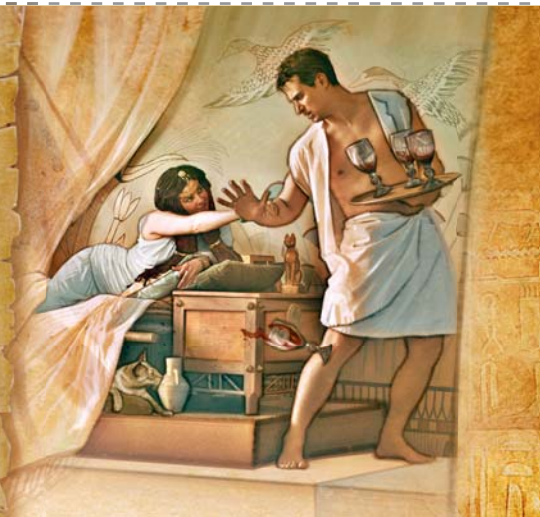

PROFILE The firstborn son of Jacob and Rachel. (Genesis 35:24) His jealous half brothers sold him into slavery in Egypt, where he spent about 13 years as a slave or prisoner. Instead of taking vengeance, Joseph forgave his repentant half brothers. (Genesis 50:15-21) Though far from home, he honored Jehovah and remained chaste, hardworking, and trustworthy.—Genesis 39:1-23.
