


Help to Answer Questions

How do you feel when someone asks you about your religious beliefs? It's normal to be nervous. Read Jeremiah's words and Jehovah's encouragement at Jeremiah 1:6-8. Jehovah helped Jeremiah, and He will help you to be able to talk to others about your beliefs!
