COLORING PAGE Read Exodus 7:19; 8:6, 17. Then, have younger children write the names of the first three plagues that struck Egypt. Finally, invite them to color the pictures.

COLLECT AND LEARN

BIBLE CHARACTER CARD Read the profile. Ask the questions on the card.
