



KORAH

PROFILE Korah was a Kohathite. He and Dathan and Abiram rebelled against Jehovah when they challenged Moses and Aaron in the wilderness. Korah along with 250 other men offered incense at the tabernacle. Jehovah executed them, showing that Aaron alone was to serve as high priest of Israel.—Numbers 16:1-50.


