Jesus was a perfect reflection of his Father, Jehovah God.

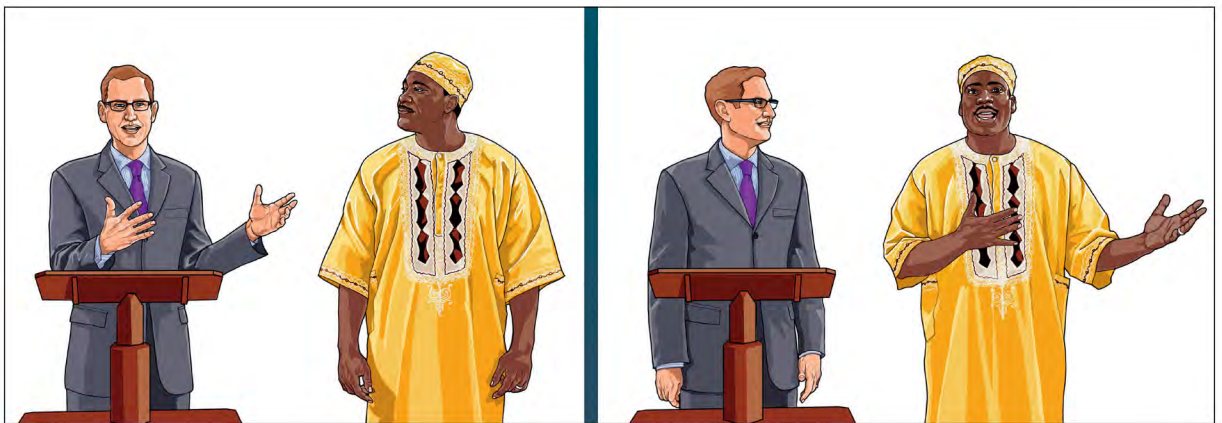
