ABRAHAM AND SARAH* WERE WORSHIPPERS OF JEHOVAH IN THE CITY OF UR. JEHOVAH SPOKE TO ABRAHAM.

GO TO THE LAND THAT I WILL SHOW YOU, AND I WILL MAKE YOU INTO A GREAT NATION.

HE ASKED US TO MOVE AWAY. WE WILL HAVE TO LEAVE OUR FRIENDS AND RELATIVES.



ABRAHAM AND SARAH LEFT UR, BUT THEY DIDN'T KNOW WHERE THEY WERE GOING . . .

. . . AND WITHOUT CHILDREN, HOW COULD ABRAHAM BECOME A GREAT NATION?

WHILE ABRAHAM CAMPED IN MAMRE, HE SAW THREE ANGELS WHO APPEARED TO BE MEN.



AS PROMISED, SARAH HAD A SON, ISAAC. ABRAHAM LOVED HIM, AND ISAAC GREW INTO A MAN WHO LOVED JEHOVAH.



LATER, TO TEST ABRAHAM, JEHOVAH TOLD HIM TO **SACRIFICE** ISAAC.



IT WAS **VERY HARD** FOR ABRAHAM TO OBEY THIS COMMAND, BUT HE AND ISAAC TRUSTED IN JEHOVAH.

JEHOVAH THEN KNEW THAT ABRAHAM WAS A **LOYAL FRIEND**, SO HE SAVED ISAAC AND MADE ABRAHAM'S OFFSPRING INTO THE NATION OF ISRAEL.
